This Agreement constitutes the entire understanding of the parties. There are no
representations or promises other than those expressly included in this Agreement. Each
party hereby states under oath that the financial representations in this Agreement are
accurate and complete, to the best of that party's information, knowledge and belief.
9) <b>EFFECT OF DIVORCE</b>
Both parties understand that this Agreement does not require them to continue to
live separately or to proceed with an action for divorce. However, if either party brings or
maintains an action for divorce, this Agreement shall be presented to the court and
